


FILE HOSTING

Cloud File Hosting Services


- Allow you to keep devices' data in the cloud
- Most are "free" but have capacity limits
- Share among devices many with local cache
- Organize just like folders in your own computer
- This is an easy way to get your pictures off of your phone
- Downside: no easier (or worse) to organize than folders on your computer


- 1. Forward the email to your Evernote email address. ...

You need a Microsoft Account

Evernote has a 3-tier cost structure

Free – only 2 devices & 60 MB upload/month


Plus – 1 GB upload/month, unlimited devices + text recognition + offline access + email \$34.99/year

Premium - 10GB upload/month + other features \$59.99/year
